



Public Mutual Declares Distributions of RM104 Million for 4 Funds

Public Bank's wholly-owned subsidiary, Public Mutual, declared distributions amounting to more than RM104 million for 4 funds. The total gross distributions declared for the financial year ended 31 January 2016 are as follows:

Funds	Gross Distribution / Unit
Public Index Fund	2.25 sen per unit
Public Islamic Optimal Growth Fund	1.00 sen per unit
Public Enhanced Bond Fund	4.75 sen per unit
Public Money Market Fund	3.00 sen per unit

Public Index Fund, Public Islamic Optimal Growth Fund and Public Enhanced Bond Fund are funds that are open for EPF Members Investment Scheme. All of the above funds are distributed by Public Mutual's unit trust consultants.
